I can honestly say that my writing, my teaching, and coaching can help you to love yourself. And that love helps you cope with life and that disability known as epilepsy. I'm aware that when you talk about self-love the reference is to a sweaty activity and not the joy of breaking a myth. Joining in the power of acquired focus aids in enabling your chi and unblocking your chakras that daily use can strangle and kill.
